

Biography for Trevor Stansbury

Mr. Stansbury was a founder and is currently the President of Supply Dynamics, a wholly owned subsidiary of O'Neal Steel.

Mr. Stansbury has been employed by, or consulted with, some of the largest aerospace and industrial concerns in the world. His consulting customers include: General Electric Aviation, GE Energy, Honeywell International, Cessna Aircraft Company, Smiths Aerospace, Westinghouse Electric Company, Electro-motive Diesel, and hundreds of their associated finished part manufacturers.
